Year 1 will be visiting the library every **Monday**.

Topics

Term 1—Rainbow at your Fingertips.

Year 1 will be exploring the artwork of Iris Scott, focusing on the finger painting "Lady in Leaves". They will be experimenting with different materials and techniques to replicate this beautiful artwork. This will also link into seasons, colours, emotions and materials.

Term 2—Great and Ghastly Events

Year 1 will discover some of the big events from British and world history some of which were great, some of which were pretty ghastly. They will consider some big events in their own lives and how this made them feel. The children will design homes, write labels and instructions.

Term 3 - Extreme Weather

Year 1 will learn about cyclones, tornadoes, snow storms, hot deserts, floods and other incredible weather. They will name the continents and oceans and investigate extreme weather from around the world, looking at the tropics, the Arctic Circle and Antarctica. As a project children will track the weather at school.

Term 4—Out of this World

Year 1 will go on an adventure through our galaxy trying to find materials to help them on their quest. They will develop their physics by considering how the sun provides us with light and comparing them to other light sources. The children will also consider how there is no sound in space and how this differs from here on Earth. Finally children will create an electrical circuit to find the missing space-ship.

Term 5—Amazing Spaces and Places

Year 1 will be learning about countries and capitals of the United Kingdom. They will discover some of the physical and human features of the United Kingdom, including some spectacular places such as Ben Nevis, The Jurassic Coast and St. Michael's Mount. The children will write reports and create stories about interesting places and study their local area.

Term 6— Field to Fork

Year 1 will learn where food comes from and consider what makes a healthy and varied diet to prepare dishes. They will visit a local farm to understand how farmers grow crops and have a chance to taste some of the food.

Topics

Term 1—Amazing Art

Year 2 have been looking at 'Tiger in a Tropical Storm' by Henri Rousseau considering why the artists used particular shades and colours to create an atmosphere. We will recreate a piece of artwork using different shades and tones for an Art Exhibition.

Term 2—Let's Remember

Year 2 will be looking at local people who lost their lives during the world wars and find out about Remembrance Sunday, including why people wear poppies at this time of year. We will learn about the different countries affected by World War I and write stories about going back to that time.

Term 3—Cracking Ideas

Year 2 will be looking at some amazing and fun 'cracking ideas' inventions from the Wallace and Gromit animations and some funny but amazing inventions from a Victorian called Heath Robinson. We will design, create and evaluate their own amazing inventions.

Term 4—Science: Plantastic!

Year 2 will be looking at how plants survive and grow. We will be growing our own plants and recording how they grow and change through the use of a plant diary. We will also identify what a plant needs to survive and consider what would happen if a plant were to be without these necessities.

Term 5—Australian Adventure

Year 2 will be discovering some of Australia's amazing places and consider how the climatic conditions of Australia affects our way of life. We will create some Aboriginal art and find out the origins of the didgeridoo and boomerang. We will also compare the Australian outback with coastal cities.

Term 6—Lift the Teacher

Year 2 will be working on a project to see if they can lift the teacher! In order to do this we will investigate levers, sliders, wheels and axels. We will design our own catapult similar to that used in the Middle Ages and attempt to safely transport an egg across an obstacle course with no cracks or breakages.
